Here's some other ideas:

If someone has MTN already, and can hook the cable to their computer (s-video cable) there are a few options.

1) That person could record live t.v. and upload the video to a free template site like: blogspot.com--you can name the blog anything, like: "byuunlv.blogspot.com". So, it takes about 1 minute to upload the video (if done after each quarter). For us on the east coast and elsewhere who don't have MTN it would allow us to watch the game 1 quarter behind, which is better than nothing.

2) The other idea is to just hook up a computer to your cable (again with an s-video--if your computer can do this) and allow someone to register a "gotomypc" or other proxy host company and watch the game live on the host computers' screen. I've fixed my parents computer in Twin Falls using this method. I log in to gotomypc.com and click on their computer name and my screen sees their desktop. Therefore, if the game were on their desktop, that's what i'd see. So, if anyone has two things: 1: computer able to connect with cable, and 2: Internet, let me know if you would let me "hack" into your game. Note: This would not have any effect on your other t.v showing the game.
