I looked on the website and could not find the MTN on the "all everything" package. Rather than look individually at the packages, I looked at the most expensive, top of the line package and it was not listed. I then called twice and talked to two different sales reps. Both confirmed that it is not presently being offered. And they told me that I could file a request for the MTN. I told them that I have filed numerous times over the past two years and I still get the same "canned" response from Dish Network. In my opinion, Dish Network is not even close to adding it. That's not good news. I've had Dish Network for the past two years and have generally been happy with the service. I think it is cheaper for me than DirecTV because I have 4 TV's which need receivers. However, with ALL the specials DirecTV ran last month (w/ the AAA membership), I finally decided it was time to switch if I want to watch the Cougs football this year. It reduced my monthly payment for the first year and raised it slightly for the second year. However, I now have two DVR's whereas before I had -0-. I hate the contract commitment for another two years, but I was going to pay one way or another. If Dish has it offered in two years, I may switch back depending on which I like better and the \$\$ of each. My switch to DirecTV will be July 3rd.....
